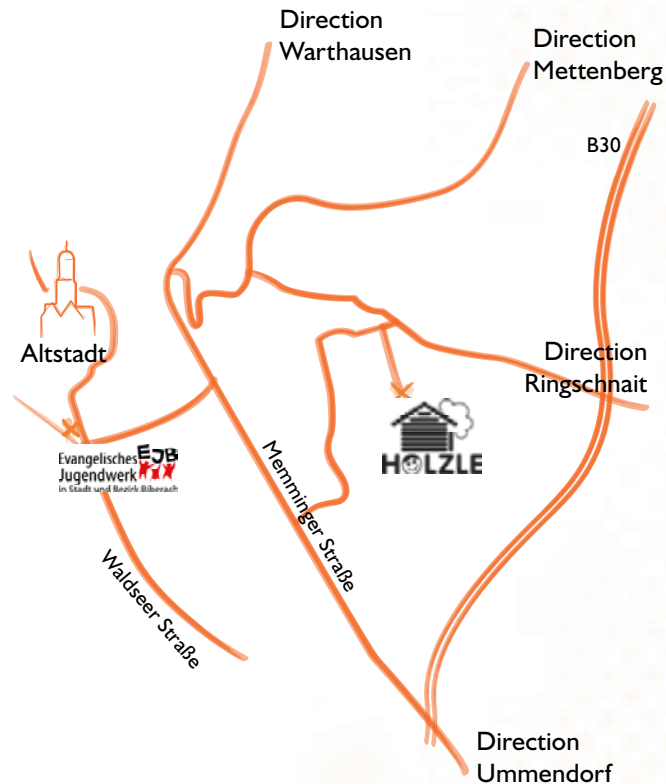

Hölzle

is under the sponsorship of the protestant parish of Biberach. With about 1000 children participating each year, it is one of the biggest institutions of its kind in Württemberg. In 3 two-week periods, the kids are looked after by our pedagogically skilled team who are put into age-matched groups. Apart from TV and computer our focus lies on action, community, and joint activities.



The History

of "Hölzle" began back in 1958 when Helmut Schmid, a local clergyman, realised his idea of a leisure facility for refugee kids. By now, those humble beginnings have led to a contemporary institution with a large building housing a big hall, a fitting kitchen, along with our distinctive log cabins located within trees at the outskirts of Biberach.

The offers

of "Hölzle" are fitted for kids from 4 to 15 years of age, regardless of origin or religion.

Toddler's Group (Kleinkindgruppe)

is made for 3 to 5-year-olds looked after by our skilled staff from 8:15 to 13:15. Their activities will be specifically fitted for children of young age. Along with our kindergarten building and our playground, we offer fun with games, crafting, and stories to listen to.

Regular Groups (reguläre Gruppen)

are addressing kids between 5 and 14 years of age who are put together in coeducational groups and are invited to spend 12 exciting days packed with adventure! In the morning, the kids will be in their groups and enjoy their specifically fitted program, whereas in the afternoon they can choose from a variety of workshops. Our schedule is complemented with a day's hike and a night's hike with overnight stay, as well as a day where parents can visit, and one day spent at the open-air pool.

Action Group (Actiongruppe)

is a special offer for 14-year-olds. Their schedule is about the same as the one of the regular groups but will be enhanced by trips to go climbing, rafting, and a 3-day bike tour.

The Food

for the kids is prepared in our very own kitchen. To us it is important that the four meals we serve every day contain regional ingredients. Those four meals are: breakfast, lunch, a dessert, as well as supper.

Care

for the children will be provided by at least 16-year old voluntary caregivers and are organised in groups of about 16 children. The caregivers will take part in several training events to be optimally prepared for the kids. 15-year old Rookies will support the caregivers in planning and performing their program.

Our Bus Shuttle Service

offers to pick up your kids at one of our numerous bus stops and to bring them back at the end of the day. During the bus' tour, there will always be two caregivers present.



Hölzle-Camp (Camp Hölzle)

is another offer we make since 2009. While being part of this 11-day summer camp, teens will experience everything that makes their summer vacation unforgettable. Activities like a hike, climbing, pure nature, and campfires will make this experience complete.
